## 14. Triana House, Triana

For a different Seville experience, stay in the small but stylish Triana House in an 18thcentury building close to the Guadalquivir river in the cool and characterful Triana neighbourhood. Design here is bold with zig-zag patterns on the walls and floors in black, white and pale teal, with art deco features. You feel as if you are staying in a private club or the house of a friend with particularly good taste. The suite on the top floor has its own terrace. While there is no restaurant — or any facilities really — breakfast is brought to your room and some of the city's best tapas bars, of both the traditional and gastrobar varieties, are in this atmospheric area.
